

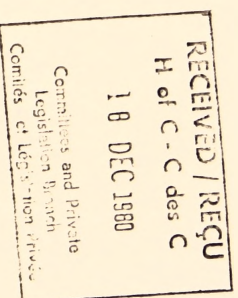

Dear Members:



At a meeting held December 1, 1980 the following recommendations were placed before the Board of Directors of the Associated Disabled Persons of B.C.

1. The presently proposed Charter of Rights is not acceptable.
2. An extension of six months is required to enable us to study the Charter and more proposals and make counter proposals.
3. A more democratic procedure must be devised to arrive at a Charter.
4. At the very least the Parliamentary Committee must travel throughout Canada.

These recommendations are derived from a meeting held Sunday, November 23 in Vancouver. The Board of Directors of the Associated Disabled Persons of B.C. endorses these recommendations in the strongest possible terms and requests that the Parliamentary Committee do all in its power to see to their adoption.
