The members of the assembly adopted the following recommendations:

"Having met to elect the members of the Ottawa FLAC, the Francophone ratepayers of Ottawa-Vanier - Rockcliffe renew their request that the Ottawa-Vanier-Rockcliffe region be given, as soon as possible, a French Language School Board and ask that Ontario be bound by Section 133 of the British North America Act."
