THE "O" DIVISION EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTRE HAS BEEN DESIGNATED AS A JOINT C.I.B./SECURITY SERVICE COMMUNICATIONS COMMAND CENTRE FOR THE SUMMER OLYMPICS. AS SUCH, IT WILL BE TIED INTO THE NATIONAL OLYMPIC COMMUNICATIONS NET BY USE OF THE SECURE SECURITY SERVICE SYSTEM AND TO LOCAL COMMAND CENTRES VIA "HOT LINES". FOR THE MONTREAL OLYMPICS, THERE WILL BE FOUR OTHER COMMAND CENTRES OPERATIONAL WITHIN "O" DIVISION, FUNCTIONING WHILE THE TORONTO EVENTS ARE BEING HELD: FINGER FIVE AT THE TORONTO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, METRO TORONTO POLICE, ONTARIO PROVINCIAL POLICE (TORONTO) AND CANADIAN FORCES BASE - DOWNSVIEW.

SECURITY SERVICE PROGRAMMES AND MANPOWER REQUIREMENTS WILL COME UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE E.O.C. COMMANDER, WHO WILL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE ALL OPERATIONAL DECISIONS AS THEY APPLY TO "O" DIVISION. FOR OLYMPIC PURPOSES THE E.O.C. WILL BECOME OPERATIONAL COMMENCING THE 12 JULY 1976 AT 8:00 AM AND WILL REMAIN OPEN 24 HOURS PER DAY UNTIL THE 1 AUGUST AT 12:00 MN.

WHILE THE E.O.C. IS OPERATIONAL, ALL MESSAGES FROM SECURITY SERVICE DETACHMENTS, "O" DIV., AND THE TORONTO SECURITY SERVICE, DEALING WITH THE SPECIFIC EVENTS AND TERRORIST ACTIVITIES, WILL BE DIRECTED TO THE "O" DIV. CENTRE FOR THE INFORMATION AND NECESSARY LOCAL ACTION BY THE COMMANDER. THE DETAILS WILL THEN BE TRANSMITTED TO HEADQUARTERS, OTTAWA, AND OTHER OPERATION CENTRES THROUGHOUT CANADA, IF REQUIRED. CONVERSELY, ALL INFORMATION CONCERNING OLYMPICS RECEIVED FROM OUTSIDE "O" DIVISION WILL BE DIRECTED TO THE E.O.C. COMMANDER, WHO WILL FORWARD SAME TO THE REQUIRED POINTS WITHIN THE DIVISION. IT IS REQUESTED ALL INCOMING OLYMPIC TRAFFIC BE ADDRESSED TO TORONTO 2 (OPERATIONS CENTRE).

FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEALING WITH HEADQUARTERS, OTTAWA, ALL OPERATIONAL INFORMATION WILL BE DIRECTED TO OTTAWA 3 (ATTENTION "D" OPS) WITH THE INFORMATION COPY DIRECTED TO THE HEADQUARTERS E.O.C. SHOULD IT BE NECESSARY TO COMMUNICATE IN A MORE DIRECT MANNER, AND WHERE NO DIRECT "HOT LINE" EXIST, THE "O" DIVISION E.O.C. CAN BE CONTACTED AT TELEPHONE NUMBERS 369-2156 OR 369-2157.

DURING THE DATES IN QUESTION (12 JULY TO 8 AUGUST) "O" DIVISION WILL PREPARE A DAILY COMPOSITE REPORT OUTLINING ALL ACTIVITIES AND SITUATIONS, TO BE SUBMITTED DAILY TO HEADQUARTERS BY 12:00 NOON.
