Object: Manpower deployment,
Olympics 1976

D/Commr. Ross outlined to Supt. Carol planning to date in this area, by reference to our A-5 of 18 March 75 and attachments. He confirmed that the Commissioner's approval was obtained for the following:

- (1) Obtain as much manpower as possible from "HQ" and "O" Division to satisfy needs of "C" and "A" Divisions during Olympic period;
- (2) Planning should provide for an 8 hour day, 5 day week whenever possible; otherwise overtime should be paid;
- (3) Either a private car allowance or provision of a bus to return men to their residence for days off.

D/Commr. Ross discussed availability of manpower and felt the following figures should be used as a guide:

"O" Division	35 to Kingston
	35 to Montreal
"HQ" Division	156 to Montreal
	50 to "A" Division
	24 to "HQ" Control Centre
	18 to Escort Officers "A", "C" & "O"

D/Commr. Ross instructed the C.O. "HQ" to consider Security Service in the requirement and suggested a figure of 75/100 to be appropriate.

"Control Centre: Of the 24 personnel estimated for "HQ" Control Centre D/Commr. Ross felt it should be Security Service.

Should include F.S.C. in Control Centre as well, thought balance of Olympic Secretariat would fold for the operational period.

Rotation of Personnel

Some functions such as hotel security would permit rotation, say every 2 - 3 weeks; while other areas requiring special training, expertise or continuity should not be rotated.

Tactical Troops

C.O. "HQ" prefers not to touch tactical troops for deployment.

D/Commr. (Ops) disagrees - says he has worked on basis that they would be used in Olympic Security - and will call on Operational Divisions for other troops if necessary.

Availability Resources "HQ"

C.O. "HQ" - current availability in an emergency is based on:

- (1) 25% of staff
- (2) minus sickness, leave etc.
- (3) minus tactical troops (162 now)

Figure arrived at about 136.

D/Commr. Ross suggested that he was not concerned if our monitoring role in "HQ" was cut out in some areas - some sections the total compliment could go (i.e. leaving a skeleton staff only).

Does not wish to disrupt 2 Divisions by sending personnel from "A" Division to "C" Division and then bringing in personnel for "O" Division that is why "O" to "C" & "A".

The reasoning behind use of "HQ" and "O" Division personnel for Olympic Security in "A" & "C" Division.

- (a) Other Divisions operationally responsible during Olympic period will experience increase in responsibilities;
- (b) Hope to obtain back-up resources from other Divisions if necessary;
- (c) very few Federal positions in contract provinces.
