On Friday 27 June 1975 S/Sgt. [redacted] and myself attended a meeting in the Office of the D.G. concerning the subject of manpower requirements for the Olympics. Those in attendance were: The D.G., D.G. (Ops) D.G. (A & P), Supt. Begalki, Supt. Friend, Supt. Nowlan, S/Sgt. [redacted] S/Sgt. [redacted] and myself. The purpose of the meeting, as explained by the D.G., was to make a final allotment for the operational branches so that he would be able to respond to the Deputy Operations as to the manpower contribution for HQ Security Service for general police duties.

Mr. Gorman reported that the response from the various branches amount to 52 personnel available for operations in Montreal. This would, of course, be sufficient for the requirement of 41 members for Security Service duties in "C" Division during the Olympics. Subsequent discussion concerning the 12 man standby force for "E" Ops. resulted in a decision by the D.G. to decline personnel for this project. His decision was based on the conclusion that should a requirement develop, surplus personnel could be found from within HQ branches for this purpose. The contribution by each branch was reviewed by Mr. Draper, i.e. "A" ~~Division~~ Ops. 26, "B" Ops. 10, who informed that he would review the status of both "B" Ops. and Training Branch with the individual commanders.

The D.G. commented that he could foresee the possibility of a contribution of about 40 to 50 members from HQ in general police duties and he would discuss the subject further with Mr. Ross.
