Attached please find [redacted] report on our recent session with the RCMP Olympics Co-ordinator. C/Supt. OUIMET gave a very comprehensive briefing for the benefit of Sam WOODEND and Wilf DOYLE of DRAE, and [redacted] and me from the Security Service. Ian TAYLOR and members of C/Supt. OUIMET's staffs were also present.

C/Supt. OUIMET highlighted problem areas which include:

- (1) who will be the customer for Security Service intelligence,
- (2) how will customer needs be determined,
- (3) who will have authority to act on the intelligence,
- (4) to what extent will intelligence be disseminated,
- (5) will there be a unified command structure,
- (6) how will the unified command structure function,
- (7) who will have authority to initiate action by the Quick Reaction Force (there appears to be some question as to whether or not a QRF has been authorized), and
- (8) who is responsible for passing information to various levels of government.

On the basis of our discussion, DRAE personnel have agreed to begin by drafting two or three fairly reasonable scenarios.
