SUBJECT / OBJET: Establishment - Olympics

I discussed with the Commissioner this afternoon the matter of Security Service personnel being available for pool duties during the '76 Olympics. I explained to the Commissioner that we have in fact 266 Regular Member positions physically based in Ottawa of which we are some 61 members short. I also explained that we are providing from HQS Security Service 41 personnel to "C" Division, plus additional needs for the Human Settlements Conference in view of the fact that the Program Officer had not agreed to additional positions for that commitment. I further explained that the HQS Security Service had assumed responsibility for manning our part in the joint operations centre in Ottawa. I advised that after meeting all of the above we could supply 15 members which was the maximum in view of our own total commitments. The Commissioner agreed and stated that he would advise the D/Commr. (Ops.) and C.O. HQ accordingly. The Commissioner suggested that the 15 members which are available may well be employed in the general manning of the Ops. Centre. I indicated that this arrangement would probably be very satisfactory. The Commissioner is, of course, well aware of the fact that all of our members are in civilian clothes, hence, not available for uniformed duty.
