

enter the V.P.'s. The individual representing the Task Force Commander at Lower Control must fill in the details, including what action he or his subordinate commanders have taken, and answer any queries from the F.M.C. Operations Centre. Also, the F.M.C. Operations Centre may order the Task Force Commander to increase the level of security at other V.P.'s if he has not already taken this action.

21. Subject to availability and to further negotiation prior to the exercise, it is estimated that Lower Control would be staffed somewhat as follows:

S.P.C.U.M.	- 1
S.Q.	- 1
G.R.C.	- 2 (To cover Ontario and Quebec)
Military	- 2 (To cover Ontario and Quebec)
O.P.P.	- 1
Kingston Police	- 1

22. Communication facilities required at Lower Control are estimated to be eight telephone instruments sharing four outside lines. These telephones and lines will be used to provide communication with all operations centres. No telephone inter-communication within Control is required.

Higher Control

23. In general the staff of Higher Control will represent government and individual force principals to whom the personnel of the co-ordination centres would report, or from whom they would seek higher level decisions. Prior to the conduct of the
